

Selected Verses Concerning JESUS IN THE OLD TESTAMENT

The Validity of the Old Testament

KJV Matthew 5:17 Think **not** that I am come to destroy **the law, or the prophets**: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil. 18 For verily I say unto you, ***Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law***, till all be fulfilled. 19 Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of heaven: but whosoever shall do and teach *them*, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven. 20 For I say unto you, That except your righteousness shall exceed *the righteousness* of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of heaven.

KJV Luke 16:16 The **law and the prophets** were until John: since that time the kingdom of God is preached, and every man presseth into it. 17 ***And it is easier for heaven and earth to pass, than one tittle of the law to fail.***

KJV Luke 16:29 Abraham saith unto him, They have **Moses and the prophets**; let them hear them. 30 And he said, Nay, father Abraham: but if one went unto them from the dead, they will repent. 31 And he said unto him, If they hear not **Moses and the prophets**, neither will they be persuaded, though one rose from the dead.

KJV Acts 13:15 And after the reading of the **law and the prophets** the rulers of the synagogue sent unto them, saying, Ye men *and* brethren, if ye have any word of exhortation for the people, say on.

KJV Acts 15:21 For Moses of old time hath in every city them that preach him, being read in the synagogues every sabbath day.

KJV Romans 7:12 Wherefore **the law** is holy, and **the commandment** holy, and just, and good.

KJV Romans 7:14 For we know that **the law** is spiritual: but I am carnal, sold under sin.

KJV Romans 7:22 For I delight in **the law** of God after the inward man:

KJV 2 Timothy 3:15 And that from a child thou hast known the **holy scriptures**, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ

Jesus. 16 All **scripture** *is* given by inspiration of God, and *is* profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: 17 That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works.

Jesus in the Old Testament

KJV Luke 24:25 Then he said unto them, O fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the **prophets** have spoken: 26 Ought not Christ to have suffered these things, and to enter into his glory? 27 And beginning at **Moses and all the prophets**, he expounded unto them in all the **scriptures** the things concerning himself.

KJV Luke 24:32 And they said one to another, Did not our heart burn within us, while he talked with us by the way, and while he opened to us the **scriptures**?

KJV Luke 24:44 And he said unto them, These *are* the words which I spake unto you, while I was yet with you, that all things must be fulfilled, which were written in the **law of Moses, and in the prophets, and in the psalms**, concerning me. 45 Then opened he their understanding, that they might understand the **scriptures**, 46 And said unto them, Thus it is written, and thus it behoved Christ to suffer, and to rise from the dead the third day: 47 And that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in his name among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.

KJV John 1:45 Philip findeth Nathanael, and saith unto him, We have found him, of whom **Moses in the law, and the prophets**, did write, Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph.

KJV John 5:39 Search the **scriptures**; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me.

KJV John 5:46 For had ye believed **Moses**, ye would have believed me: for he wrote of me. 47 But if ye believe not his **writings**, how shall ye believe my words?

KJV Acts 13:26 Men *and* brethren, children of the stock of Abraham, and whosoever among you feareth God, to you is the word of this salvation sent. 27 For they that dwell at Jerusalem, and their rulers, because they knew him not, nor yet the **voices of the prophets which are read** every sabbath day, they have fulfilled *them* in condemning *him*. 28 And though they found no cause of death *in him*, yet desired they Pilate that he should be slain. 29 And when they had fulfilled all that was **written of him**, they took *him* down from the tree, and laid *him* in a sepulchre. 30 But God raised him from the dead: 31 And he was seen many days of them which came up with him from Galilee to Jerusalem, who are his witnesses unto the people. 32 And we declare unto you glad tidings, how that the promise which was made unto the fathers, 33 God hath fulfilled the same

unto us their children, in that he hath raised up Jesus again; **as it is also written** in the second psalm, Thou art my Son, this day have I begotten thee. 34 And as concerning that he raised him up from the dead, *now* no more to return to corruption, he said on this wise, I will give you the sure mercies of David. 35 Wherefore he saith also in another *psalm*, Thou shalt not suffer thine Holy One to see corruption. 36 For David, after he had served his own generation by the will of God, fell on sleep, and was laid unto his fathers, and saw corruption: 37 But he, whom God raised again, saw no corruption. 38 Be it known unto you therefore, men *and* brethren, that through this man is preached unto you the forgiveness of sins: 39 And by him all that believe are justified from all things, from which ye could not be justified by the law of Moses.

KJV Acts 17:2 And Paul, as his manner was, went in unto them, and three sabbath days reasoned with them out of **the scriptures**, 3 Opening and alleging, that Christ must needs have suffered, and risen again from the dead; and that this Jesus, whom I preach unto you, is Christ.

KJV Acts 24:14 But this I confess unto thee, that after the way which they call heresy, so worship I the God of my fathers, believing all things which are written in **the law and in the prophets**: 15 And have hope toward God, which they themselves also allow, that there shall be a resurrection of the dead, both of the just and unjust.

KJV Acts 26:22 Having therefore obtained help of God, I continue unto this day, witnessing both to small and great, saying none other things than those which **the prophets and Moses** did say should come: 23 That Christ should suffer, *and* that he should be the first that should rise from the dead, and should shew light unto the people, and to the Gentiles.

KJV Acts 28:23 And when they had appointed him a day, there came many to him into *his* lodging; to whom he expounded and testified the kingdom of God, persuading them concerning Jesus, both out of **the law of Moses, and out of the prophets**, from morning till evening.

KJV Romans 1:2 (Which he had promised afore **by his prophets in the holy scriptures**.)

KJV Romans 15:4 For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through patience and comfort of **the scriptures** might have hope.

KJV Romans 16:26 But now is made manifest, and by **the scriptures of the prophets**, according to the commandment of the everlasting God, made known to all nations for the obedience of faith:

KJV 1 Corinthians 15:3 For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins **according to the scriptures**; 4 And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day **according to the scriptures**:

KJV Galatians 3:24 Wherefore **the law** was our schoolmaster *to bring us* unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith.
